1 PRE-SERVICE CANDIDATE

- Completed Bachelor's degree or higher; official transcripts shows degree
- Submitted Program Application with official transcripts from all colleges
- Paid \$500 fee (\$250 with application; \$250 two weeks before 1st class

2 INTERN ELIGIBLE CANDIDATE

- Completed pre-service requirements (160 hours program or valid credential)
- Submitted to Admissions proof CBEST passed (or passed multiple subject CSET + Writing Skills Test)
- Demonstrated subject matter competency: Submitted to Admissions proof CSET passed (exception: single subjects can provide SMC document from their college)
- Completed U.S. Constitution requirement for teachers
- Received Intern Eligible document from Admissions

3 INTERN

- Obtained a teaching contract with a participating district
- Submitted employment verification to Admissions
- Received Intern confirmation letter from Admissions; assigned to an intern cohort
- Assigned a practicum supervisor
