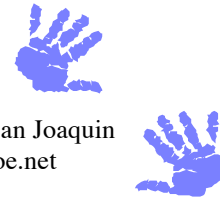

PAYMENT

The intern tuition (does not begin until you are assigned to a cohort and attend your cohort orientation) is paid by automatic payroll deductions of \$200/month; available in most school districts. There are no book fees; we loan texts for each course. (The monthly deduction amount can change prior to the first class date.)

SCHEDULES

Courses (pre-service and intern) usually meet 4:30-7:30pm, two times a week, either Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/Thursday (depends on cohort assignment and schedules; candidates do not have a choice). Most intern cohort schedules are a traditional calendar (e.g. holiday breaks and about two months off during the summer).
